The current position involves applying for a postdoctoral fellowship full-time contract. If you are passionate about contributing to our research, we encourage you to apply.

Project Overview:

The selected candidate will join a translational research multidisciplinary team at the Hospital de Girona Dr. Josep Trueta and the research laboratory of the Institute for Biomedical Research of Girona (IdIBGi). The focus of the project is to investigate the role of endothelial dysfunction in endothelial cells derived from patients with sleep apnea syndrome and pulmonary hypertension. The translational research will delve into identifying novel mechanisms and treatments targeting endothelial dysfunction, thromboembolism, angiogenesis, metabolism, organoid 3D systems, oxidative stress, and animal models. The research will employ a wide range of molecular and cellular techniques, *in vitro* organoid 3D models, and *in vivo* animal models.
